

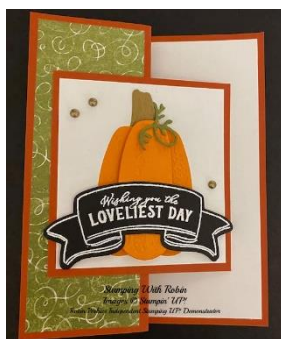

Hello Harvest

Recipe

- Card Base Cajun Craze Cardstock 5 ½ x 8 scored at 2 1/8 & 4 1/4. Card is Portrait
- Rustic Harvest DSP 2 1/8 x 5 ¼
- Card Front Cajun Craze Cardstock 3 ¼ x 3 ½
 - a. Basic White Cardstock 3 x 3 ¼
 - b. Pumpkin Pie Cardstock 3 x 5
 - c. Rustic Harvest DSP 1 7/8 x 5 ¼
 - d. Scrap of Soft Suede Cardstock, Mossy Meadow Cardstock and Basic Black Cardstock
- Inside of card
 - Basic White Cardstock 4 x 5 ¼

Supplies

- Hello Harvest Stamp Set # 159644
- Rustic Harvest Dies # 159643
- Cardstock – Cajun Craze # 119684, Pumpkin Pie # 105117, Soft Suede # 115318, Mossy Meadow # 133676, Basic Black # 121045 and Basic White # 159276
- Designer Paper Series (DSP) Rustic Harvest # 159633
- Ink – Tuxedo Black # 132708, Cajun Craze # 147085 and Crushed Curry # 147087
- White Embossing Powder – Basic group # 155554 Versamark Ink # 102283
- Rustic Metallic Dots # 159082
- Envelope # 102619

Directions

1. Fold your Rustic Harvest Cardstock Base in half at 4¼. Next, take card front at the 2 1/8 score line - fold the panel back to the left side. Place the DSP on this panel.
2. Die cut the 2 pumpkin pieces, Stem piece from Soft Suede and a tendril from Mossy Meadow. Next assemble the pumpkin.
3. Emboss "Wishing you the Loveliest Day" stamp with White embossing powder on Basic Black Cardstock. Die cut when embossing is completed.
4. Take the remaining Cajun Craze Cardstock and adhere the Basic White Cardstock 3 x 3 ¼ onto it. Place the pumpkin in center of the front panel. Place your embossed banner towards bottom of the pumpkin. Place a dimensionals on each end of the banner.
5. Place Rustic Metallic Dots on the card front panel.
6. Take the card front panel, use Stampin Seal Plus or Tear & Tape, put 2 or 3 long strips on the back of the lefthand side of the card front. *** If you place anymore adhesive on the back side of the card front you want, be able to open the card up.
7. Place the last piece of Basic White Card on the inside of the card. Pick a sentiment that you'll be able to fit behind the card front so that it doesn't show when the card isn't open. I finished with 1 Cajun Craze and 1 Crushed Curry Leaf on the left-hand side, adding a little more fall to the card.

I hope you enjoy the "Hello Harvest" Card today.
